IMPORTANT DATES

- May 1, 2019: Application form along with a non-refundable application fee of \$25 is due (late applications will be accepted until admission is full).
- May 10th, 11th & 12th, 2019: Audition dates (We will send you specific audition date/time information the first week of May)
- May 20th, 2019: Applicants will be notified of their acceptance status and scholarship award (if applicable) via email before May 20th.
- June 1st, 2019: A non-refundable deposit of \$300 due. You may choose to pay in full at this time.
- July 1st, 2019: The final remaining balance due. (Tuition is non-refundable)

REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS

1. Duration: 10-15 minutes total
2. Schedule a Live Audition or send in a Recording (all applicants must audition, including past WAYA students)
3. Recommended audition repertoire:
 - Strings
 - One 3-octave major scale and arpeggio (key of your choice)
 - One 3-octave minor scale and arpeggio (key of your choice)
 - Two contrasting pieces of your choice demonstrating your current playing level (preferably one slow and one fast piece)
 - Winds & Brass
 - One 2-octave major scale and arpeggio (key of your choice)
 - One 2-octave minor scale and arpeggio (key of your choice)
 - Two contrasting pieces of your choice demonstrating your current playing level (preferably one slow and one fast piece)
