- <u>April 30, 2020</u>: Application form along with a non-refundable application fee of \$25 is due (late applications will be accepted until admission is full).
- May 15, 16 & 17, 2020: Audition dates (we will send you specific audition date/time information the first week of May)
- May 25, 2020: Applicants will be notified of their acceptance status and scholarship award (if applicable) via email.
- June 1, 2020: A non-refundable deposit of \$300 is due. You may choose to pay in full at this time.
- <u>July 1, 2020</u>: The final remaining balance is due. The tuition is non-refundable.

REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Duration: 10-15 minutes total
- 2. Schedule a Live Audition or send in a Recording (all applicants must audition, including past WAYA students)
- 3. Recommended audition repertoire:
 - Strings
 - o Two 3-octave major scale and arpeggio (key of your choice)
 - o Two 3-octave melodic minor scale and arpeggio (key of your choice)
 - Two contrasting pieces of your choice demonstrating your current playing level (preferably one slow and one fast piece)
 - Winds & Brass
 - o Two 2-octave major scale and arpeggio (key of your choice)
 - o Two 2-octave melodic minor scale and arpeggio (key of your choice)
 - Two contrasting pieces of your choice demonstrating your current playing level (preferably one slow and one fast piece)
 - Piano
 - o Two 4-octave major scale and arpeggio (key of your choice)
 - o Two 4-octave melodic minor scale and arpeggio (key of your choice)
 - Two contrasting pieces of your choice demonstrating your current playing level (preferably one slow and one fast piece)
